TUITION DISCOUNT BENEFIT POLICY

- f. Children or surviving spouses of active duty Service members who have died in the line of duty after September 10, 2001 who are eligible for education benefits under the Marine Gunnery Sergeant John David Fry Scholarship (Fry Scholarship).
 - g. Spouses or dependent children of Service members who have exercised their “transferability option” under the Post-9/11 Bill and transferred all or some unused education benefits to them.
- 3. Prospective graduate students meeting one of the above classifications must – at time of formal application to SMU’s Bobby B. Lyle School of Engineering – submit signed documentation provided by the appropriate government agency, verifying eligibility. Qualified applicants admitted to SMU’s Bobby B. Lyle School of Engineering will be charged a tuition rate reflecting the scheduled discount at the time of official registration for classes.
- 4. SMU’s Bobby B. Lyle School of Engineering policy regarding tuition discounts for eligible persons, so stated, is not to be regarded as irrevocable. The University reserves the right to change or cancel, at any time and without prior notice, any provision or requirement stated herein. The Dean of SMU’s Bobby B. Lyle School of Engineering may restrict tuition discounts or extend incentives to employees of other government agencies, with the approval of the President.
