

The College and Career Advising Program (CCAP) was created in 2010 by Dallas ISD to increase student college applications, scholarship applications, participation in college entrance exams, and parental involvement in the college admissions and financial aid processes. The program is managed by Dallas ISD Postsecondary Partnerships and Programs department. For the 2023-24 school year, the program was funded through the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) fund.

The CCAP program was established to maintain, support, and sustain a college- and career-going culture at each high school campus. The CCAP program provided targeted supports and services to students in grades nine through 12 at 39 high schools to increase postsecondary plan completion.
