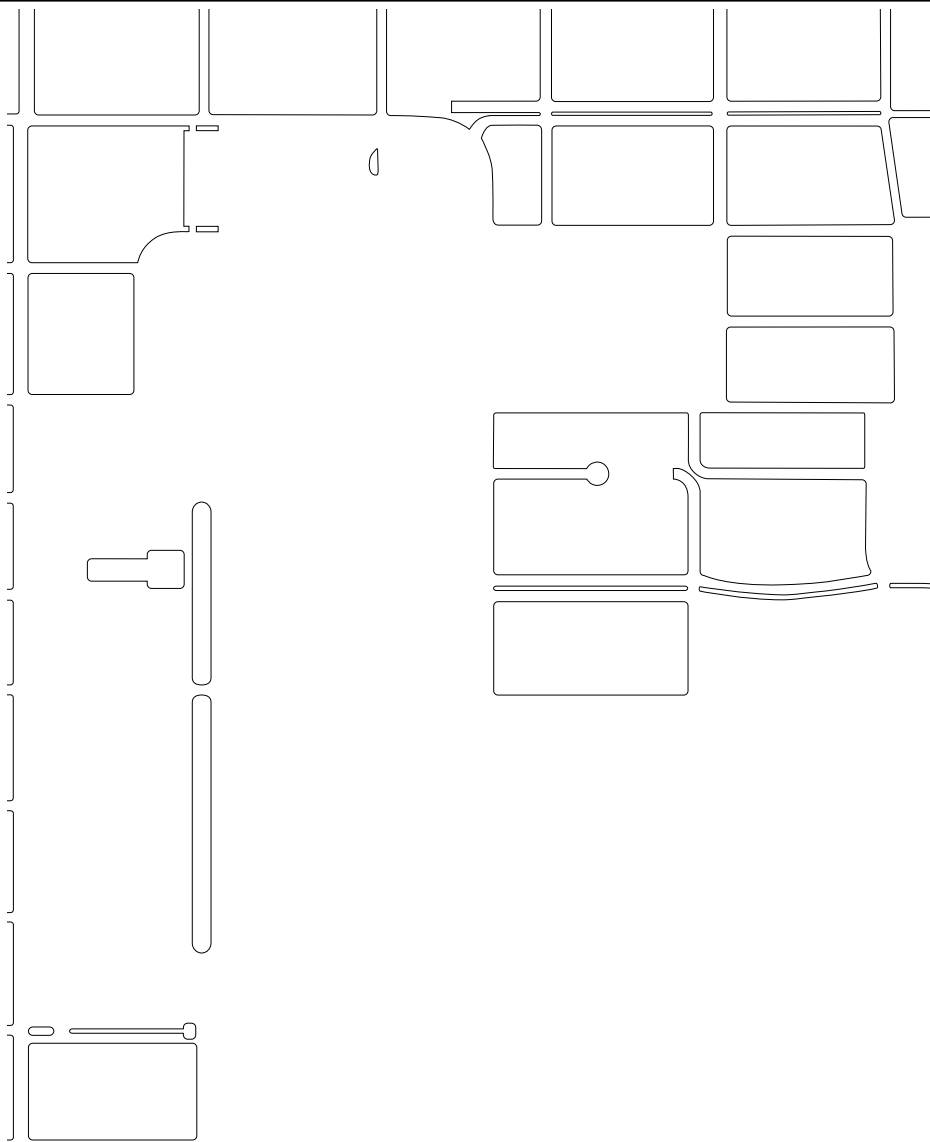

MAINTENANCE OF CAMPUS FACILITIES

POLICY FOR REPORTING THE ANNUAL DISCLOSURE OF CRIME STATISTICS

1. The purpose of this policy is to ensure that the annual disclosure of crime statistics is accurate, reliable, and consistent with the requirements of the relevant legislation.

2. This policy applies to all staff members involved in the collection, analysis, and reporting of crime statistics.

3. The following principles shall govern the reporting of crime statistics:

- a. Accuracy: All data reported must be accurate and based on reliable sources.
- b. Consistency: Reporting methods and formats must be consistent across all reports.
- c. Transparency: The sources and methods used to collect and analyze the data must be clearly stated.
- d. Confidentiality: All data reported must be kept confidential and not disclosed to unauthorized persons.
- e. Timeliness: Reports must be submitted and published in a timely manner.

4. The following procedures shall be followed for the reporting of crime statistics:

- The relevant data shall be collected and analyzed in accordance with the relevant legislation and standards.
- The results of the analysis shall be reviewed and approved by the relevant authority.
- The approved results shall be reported in the annual disclosure of crime statistics.
- The reporting process shall be monitored and audited to ensure compliance with this policy.
